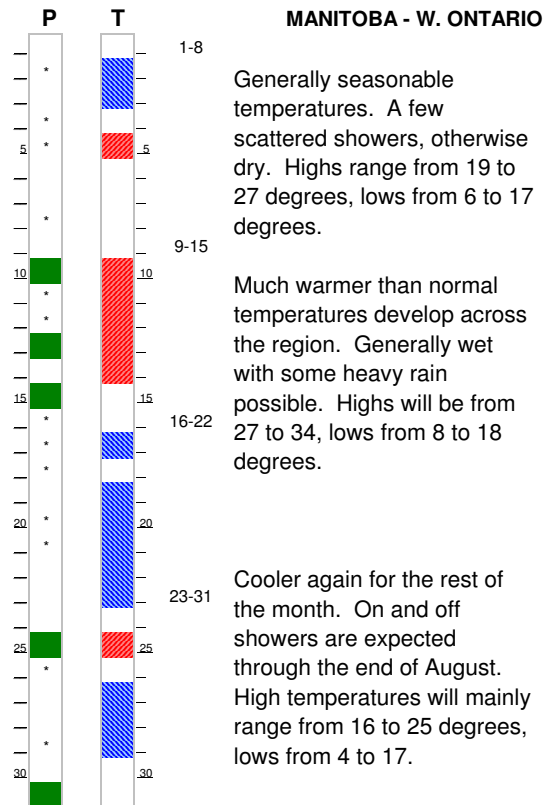
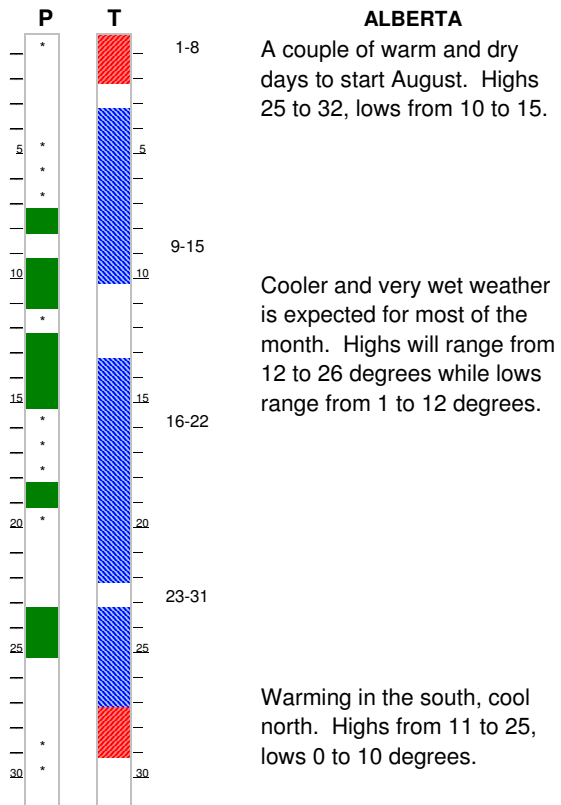
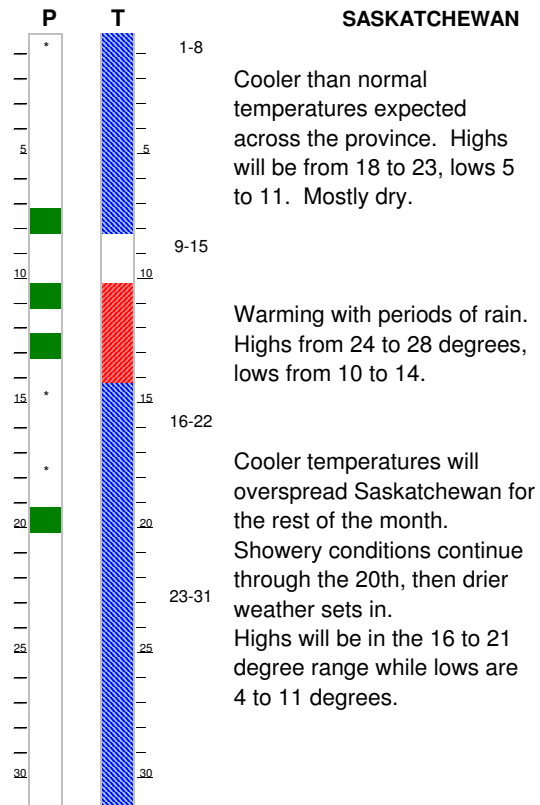
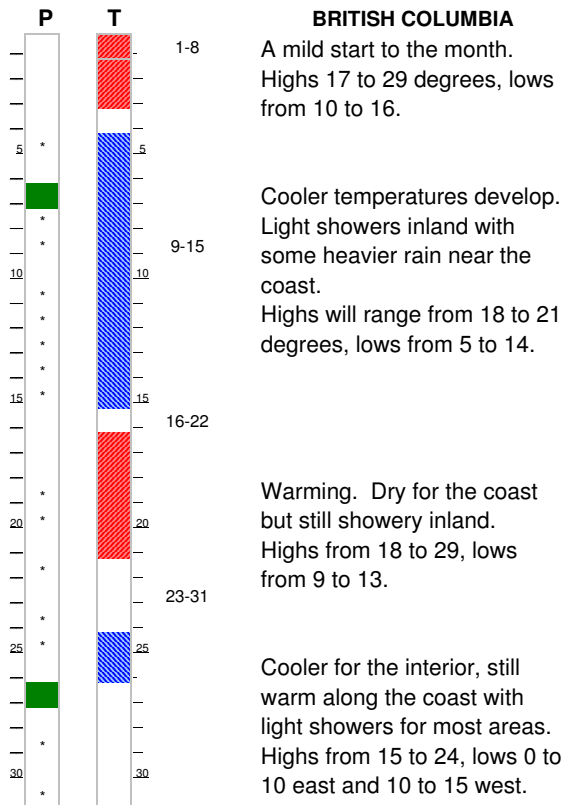
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**Monthly Climatic Outlook**

August 2010 is expected to be very cool and wet for most of Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba. More seasonable temperatures will be found across British Columbia, especially near the coast. Rainfall for BC will be a bit above normal for coastal locations but the interior will be quite wet. Drier conditions and near normal temperatures are predicted for western Ontario.
